ARRIVAL AT BRAWDY

ACCESS ON SATURDAY IS VIA GATE 21 (11:00HRS - 1600HRS). You will be met at the gates by military personnel who will request your name


Once verified, you will be issued with an individual wristband which <u>MUST</u> be worn at all times when at the venue.

<u>These wristbands will be required by ALL persons to regain admission on</u> <u>Saturday/Sunday morning irrespective of your role at the event.</u>

DO NOT ARRIVE ON SATURDAY BEFORE 11:00 AS THE GATES WILL BE LOCKED AND YOU WILL BLOCK THE APPROACH ROAD.

<u>Please drive quietly and courteously through the surrounding area as we rely</u> totally on the support of the local population for the continued use of the venue.

Please remember that 100s of Competitors and 50 Marshals cars will be travelling along these routes on Saturday and early on Sunday morning and it will only take one indiscretion to upset the locals or the MOD, leading to loss of venue.



Signing on opens at 12.30 till 15.30

Upon arrival, please go to sign on with the Chief Marshall his location is on the map provided he will instruct you to where your located

Please ensure that you have all necessary equipment including your RED FLAG before you leave for your location

It should be noted that on the Saturday evening the airfield gate <u>WILL</u> be locked overnight between 9pm – 6am.

OVERNIGHT PARKING & CAMPING

The MoD has graciously granted permission for overnight camping and parking of motor homes as long as we abide by their rules which state:
